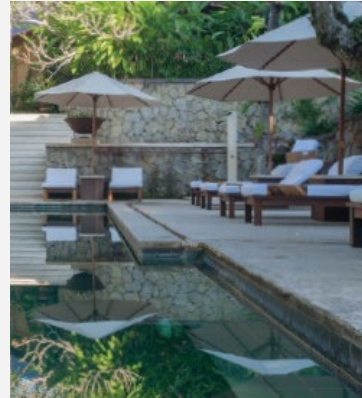

COUNTRY IN THE CLOUDS by I Wayan Sujana Suklu

...This ecological tool carries a simple story while offering meaning about the journey of human life in the world...

Traditional agriculture produces many unusual objects, one of which is the *bubu* fish trap. The elongated shape is like a creature that lives in the irrigation ditches of the rice fields. The *bubu* is made of bamboo and its function is to trap bait, through a shuttle system where a fish can enter but cannot get out.

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During *Tumpek Wariga*, there is a belief that Balinese people still preserve until nowadays such as: it is not allowed to cut trees, as well as pick fruit, flowers and leaves. Ethically, Hindus want to harmonize themselves with nature, both through ceremonies and concrete actions.

In the offering, people use porridge. It is a symbol of fertility. The porridge is made in two colors, red and white. The red porridge is symbol of masculine, while the white one is symbol of feminine. The union of the two elements causes the birth of life.

Overall, *Tumpek Wariga* exists to remind humans of all the great services of God, especially of his



creation of plants. Without plants there will be no oxygen, there will be no food for human and other living being. Through this holy day, let us always preserve our environment. Thus, we all can live peacefully for a long and even longer time together.

COUNTRY IN THE CLOUDS by I Wayan Sujana Suklu

A Note from the Artist

Traditional agriculture produces many unusual objects, one of which is the *bubu* fish trap. The elongated shape is like a creature that lives in the irrigation ditches of the rice fields. The *bubu* is made of bamboo and its function is to trap bait, through a shuttle system where a fish can enter but cannot get out. This ecological tool carries a simple story while offering meaning about the journey of human life in the world.

I revitalize the form of the *bubu* in the perspective of the planets and life on our own planet. To achieve this, eight forms of *bubu* were enlarged in the medium of rattan, with textured colors and repeating woven lines.

The visual concept is to depict the *bubu* with its associations of trapping, ecology, and cosmological meaning as symbolic of a country - an imaginary country that can give different impressions to different viewers. The *bubu* object is suspended from the ceiling as "the land above the clouds".
